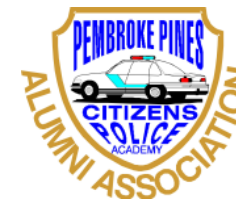

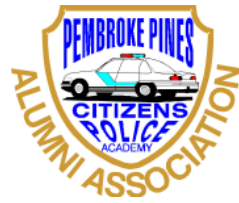

We can't wait until next time ~editor

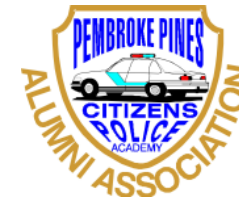
