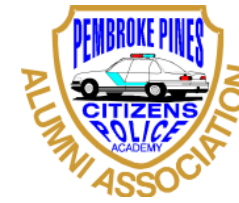
Membership fees are due on January 1st of each year. It entitles you to participate in the various functions, training, and programs offered.

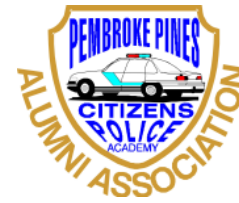
Service Note:
