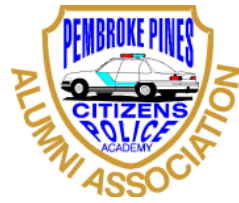
Pembroke Pines Police Safety Message

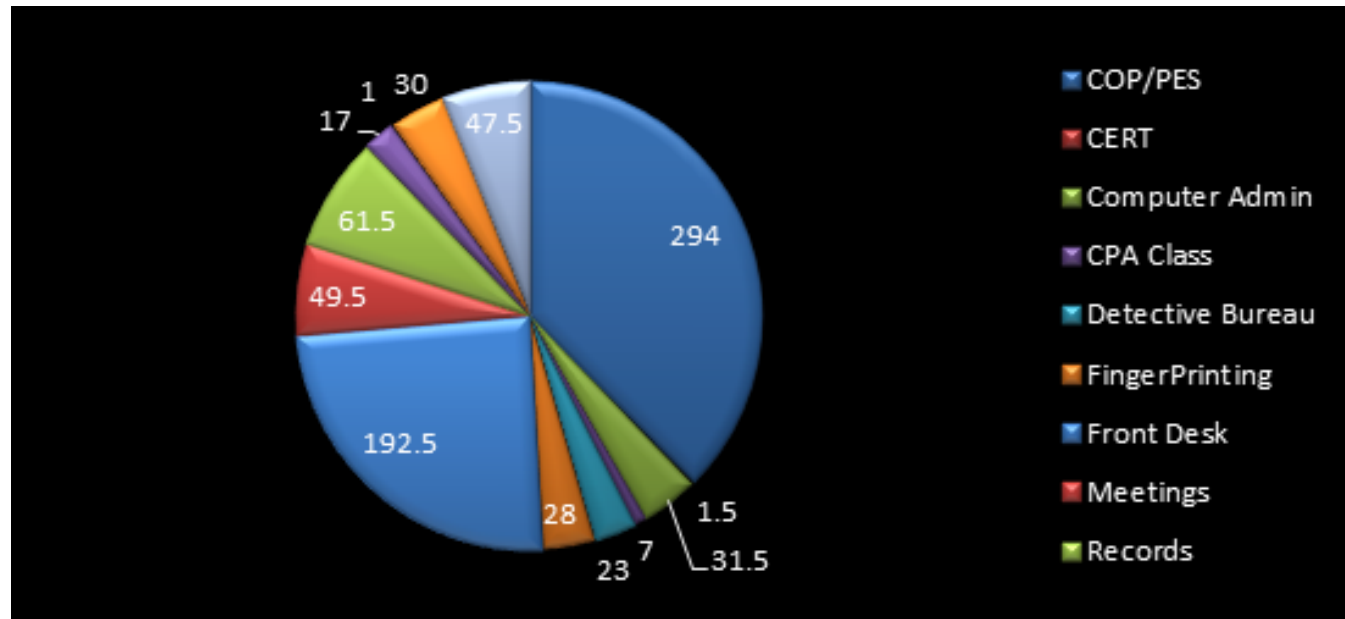

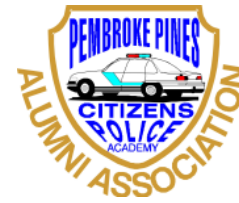
