Hope to see you at our meeting.

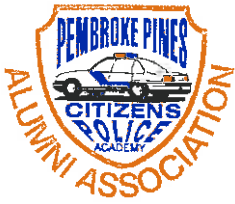

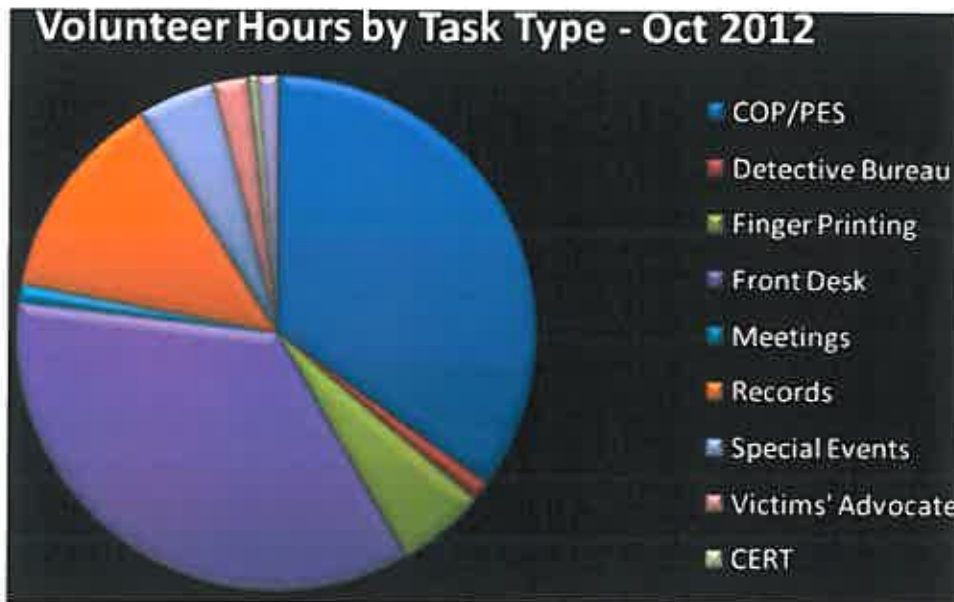
